



General sales conditions Yonex Dutch Open



By paying the entrance fee, the visitor agrees to the following conditions:

- ✓ If the Yonex Dutch Open as a whole is canceled for whatever reason, 100% of the entrance fee will be reimbursed or the ticket can be used for the next edition of the Yonex Dutch Open.
- ✓ The organization of the Yonex Dutch Open Badminton cannot be held liable in the event of cancellation, discontinuation, not playing or not completing a match. The costs of the entrance fee will not be reimbursed.
- ✓ The organization of the Yonex Dutch Open Badminton reserves the right to change starting times of parts in the program.
- ✓ Damage suffered in the sports hall cannot be recovered from the organization of the Yonex Dutch Open Badminton.
- ✓ The organization of the Yonex Dutch Open Badminton cannot take responsibility for minors.
- ✓ Persons who cannot be held responsible for their own actions must be accompanied by an attendant who is responsible for these persons.
- ✓ Visitors who disrupt the event in any way, cause damage or personal injury, will be held personally liable for this.
